Reports to: Kaposia’s Site Coordinator

Location: Can be done from anywhere!

Time Commitment: Pen Pals are asked to commit to writing once or twice per month for one year minimum. Pen Pals can recommit each year.

Qualifications: Dependability, pleasant manner, patience.

Age Requirement: All ages welcome and families are encouraged!

Support: No special training is required for this position, although information on data privacy can be made available.
